Cookies are used to improve your experience during your use or visit, from certain technologies (“Cookies”).

The use of these technologies is primarily in accordance with the Personal Data Protection Law No. 6698 (“KVKK” or “Law”) are carried out in accordance with the legislation we are subject to.

The purpose of this Cookie Policy is to provide you with information regarding the personal data obtained due to the processing of personal data using cookies used during the use of the Platforms. In this text, we would like to explain to you what types of cookies we use on our site and applications for what purposes and how you can control these cookies.

As a company, we may stop using the cookies we use on our site and applications if necessary, change their types or functions, or add new cookies to our site and applications. Therefore, we reserve the right to change the provisions of this Cookie Policy at any time. Method and Legal Reason for Collecting Personal Data

Your personal data is collected based on the legal reason of our Company's legitimate interest through cookies in electronic environment within the scope of your visit to our website or due to your use of our applications. Promotional activities carried out through targeting and profiling are only carried out with your explicit consent. Your collected personal data is also used for the purposes specified in this Cookie Policy within the scope of the personal data processing conditions and purposes specified in Articles 5 and 6 of the Law. can be processed.

To Whom and For What Purpose Personal Data Can Be Transferred

As a company, we may share your personal data within the scope of the Cookie Policy with legally authorized public institutions, limited to the realization of the above-mentioned purposes and in accordance with the legislation.

Which Cookies Are Used for What Purposes?

As the COMPANYY, we use cookies for various purposes on our site and applications and process your personal data through these cookies. These objectives are mainly as follows:

- **To perform the basic functions necessary for the operation of the Site and applications.** For example, logged-in members do not need to re-enter passwords when visiting different pages on the Site.

What Are Your Rights as a Data Owner?

Pursuant to Article 11 of the KVK Law, data owners,

- To learn whether personal data is processed,
- Requesting information if personal data has been processed,
- To learn the purpose of processing personal data and whether they are used in accordance with their purpose,
- To know the third parties to whom personal data is transferred domestically,
- To request correction of personal data in case of incomplete or incorrect processing and to request notification of the transaction made in this context to third parties to whom personal data has been transferred,

- Although it has been processed in accordance with the provisions of the KVK Law and other relevant laws, to request the deletion or destruction of personal data in case the reasons requiring its processing disappear and to request that the transaction made in this context be notified to third parties to whom personal data has been transferred,
- To object to the emergence of a result against the person himself by analyzing the processed data exclusively through automated systems,
- Requesting compensation for damage in case of damage due to unlawful processing of personal data

Your request will be finalized within 30 days and a response will be sent. As a rule, requests are met free of charge, but if fulfilling the requirements of the request requires expenses, the "Communiqué on the Procedures and Principles of Application to the Data Controller" stipulated in Article 7; *"If the application of the person concerned is to be answered in writing, no fee is charged for up to 10 pages. A transaction fee of 1 TL may be charged for each page over 10 pages. If the response to the application is given in a recording medium such as CD or flash memory, the fee that may be requested by the data controller cannot exceed the cost of the recording medium."* Pursuant to the provision, a fee may be requested by the COMPANY.
